## **Regulation No 107 of the Economic Commission for Europe of the United Nations**

Uniform provisions concerning the approval of category  
M2 or M3 vehicles with regard to their general construction

Dear Customer,

It has come to our attention that **United Nations Economic Commission for Europe** ([www.unece.org](http://www.unece.org)) is planning on altering the emergency exit regulations. A document has been released on July 20<sup>th</sup> 2012, where the new emergency exit regulation proposals are to be seen. The proposed document contains important changes about emergency exit regulations:

- Section 7.6.1.11 defines the amount of emergency exits required.
- Section 7.6.2.1.5 defines the minimum opening size of the emergency exits.
