Dear Valued Customer,

Regarding the coronavirus (Covid-19) and its potential influence to the supply-chain, we would like to inform you of the latest status:

On **March 16, 2020**, the Government outlined further measures to address the coronavirus situation in Finland. These measures are designed to protect the population and to safeguard the functioning of society and the economy. The policy is valid until **April 13, 2020**. The government, in cooperation with the President of the Republic, has stated that the country is facing exceptional circumstances due to the coronavirus situation.

The law of emergency state was introduced and came into force on **March 19, 2020**. Schools, day care and borders are closed (not for goods) from **March 18, 2020** onwards.

Valeo group's top priority during this period of uncertainty remains to protect the health of all employees, and limit the risk of transmission of the virus at the workplace. Therefore, as of **March 19th**, Valeo employees will promote remote work as much as possible while securing business continuity.

These exceptional measures are affecting the availability of Valeo TCV Finland personnel and we cannot ignore the likelihood that as per March 23, for reason of force majeure, we might be prevented from fulfilling some of our commitments.

We trust that the local governments are doing the maximum to control the situation and we are supporting our teams to stay healthy and protected.
